Subject: Pronunciation
Topic: Basic Rules of Vowel Sounds

## Overview:

There are a series of rules that were established with the purpose to have a system of sounds. The English language has two kinds of letter: vowels and consonants. The vowels are $\boldsymbol{a}, \boldsymbol{e}, \boldsymbol{i}, \boldsymbol{o}, \boldsymbol{u}$ and sometimes $\boldsymbol{y}$ or $\boldsymbol{w}$. There are long vowel sounds and short vowel sounds which in occasions combined, may transform a vowel with a single sound into a vowel with multiple sounds.
