Subject: Pronunciation

Topic: Basic Rules of Vowel Sounds

Overview:

There are a series of rules that were established with the purpose to have a system of sounds. The English language has two kinds of letter: vowels and consonants. The vowels are **a**, **e**, **i**, **o**, **u** and sometimes **y** or **w**. There are long vowel sounds and short vowel sounds which in occasions combined, may transform a vowel with a single sound into a vowel with multiple sounds.
